

NEW HAMPSHIRE 2017 WINTER ROUND ROBIN OPEN

Format: Giant round robin groups, minimum group size of 6. All players entered will be assigned to groups of relatively equal size based on current USATT rating. Unrated players should provide an estimate of their rating (if you have friends who are close to your level and have a rating, then that will be helpful for us to know). If you have no idea what your rating should be, then come to the tournament 30 minutes early so that we can watch you play and make our own estimate. You will play everyone in your assigned group once. All matches are best 3 out of 5, 11-point games. Prizes: Group A 1st place \$100, 2nd place \$60. In all other groups, 1st and 2nd place will receive trophies.

Deadline: Received by March 8, 2017. Entry fee is \$40 if pre-paid, \$50 at the tournament site (also applies to entries lost in the mail). Eligibility: Entrants must be current USATT members or purchase a USATT membership or tournament pass at the tournament. Bring your membership card or a valid receipt from a previous tournament. Memberships: Adult 1-yr \$75, 3-yr \$210, 5-yr \$325; Household 1-yr \$150; Junior 1-yr (17 or younger) \$45; Junior 3-yr (14 or younger) \$125; Collegiate 1-yr \$45 (must bring a copy of proof of enrollment that we can keep). Tournament passes: \$20. USATT rating published on March 1, 2017 will be used for seeding.

Rules: All USATT rules and regulations apply. If in doubt, wear dark, solid-colored shirt and shorts, tennis shoes or sneakers; or see USATT dress code in USATT rules section 3.2.2.

Equipment: Only ITTF/USATT approved. Donic/Butterfly tables, Nittaku or XuShaoFa 3-star white poly 40+ balls.

Food: Food and drink is available for sale courtesy of Souhegan High TTC and at a local deli.

Check-in: The gym will open at 8:30AM. Check-in will be from 9-10AM. Matches will begin by 10AM. Late entries must arrive by 9:30AM and must pay the late fee. Note, it is **NOT** guaranteed that late entries will be accepted. If you must leave the tournament site after you have checked in, you must notify the control desk or be liable to default. Default time is match time. We expect to be done by 5PM (tbd).

Directions to Souhegan High School:

From the North and East:

Follow Route 93 South to Manchester, NH and take the exit for 101 West to Bedford/Milford. Continue to follow signs for 101 West to the exit for 101A Milford/Nashua. Bear right off the exit ramp onto 101A East towards Nashua. At the first set of traffic lights turn left onto Route 122 and take your immediate right onto Stearns Road. Continue to the end of Stearns Road and turn left onto Boston Post Road. Souhegan High School is on the right.

From the West

Follow Route 101 East to the exit for 101A Milford/Nashua. Bear right off the exit ramp onto 101A East towards Nashua. At the first set of traffic lights turn left onto Route 122 and take your immediate right onto Stearns Road. Continue to the end of Stearns Road and turn left onto Boston Post Road. Souhegan High School is on the right.

From the South:

Follow Route 3 North to Nashua. Take Exit 8 Amherst/Milford. Continue on this road/ramp and at the end of the road turn right onto Route 101A West. Continue on 101A until you see (PC) Connection Plaza on the left and Home Depot/Dunkin Doughnuts on the right. At the next traffic lights bear right onto Boston Post Road. (If you see Joey's Dinner on the right you missed the turn.) Follow Boston Post Road until you see Souhegan High School on the right.

Participants should take the main Souhegan school entrance marked by a granite SHS sign and SHS events board, located between the two athletic fields. Continue to the large parking lot on the left behind the school. Enter the school through the doors to the left of the glass walled cafeteria to get to the main gym.
